Spending time at Saint Vincent College as an international student? Costs vary according to the program in which you are enrolled. First, it's important to determine the program in which you are interested. Are you a:

- Traditional student, working toward a four-year degree?
- Integrated Language Studies student, working to improve your English for college study?
- Traveling student on a study abroad visit?
- Graduate student in a master's or doctoral program?

Students will receive a bill for the amount they owe, but it will be sent by the traditional mail system and may be subject to prolonged delivery times. Please contact the College at any time for a current bill amount. Items such as insurance, books, etc., are included in the estimate as costs but ones that Saint Vincent College does not necessarily provide. Books may be purchased on campus and insurance should be arranged prior to entering the United States. Please contact the Admission office for any needed clarification.

Costs for students on exchange programs may vary according to institutional agreements. Typically, visiting study abroad students pay costs of room, board and International Welcome Week fees to Saint Vincent College and pay tuition and related fees to their home university.



INTEGRATED LANGUAGE STUDIES:

Tuition per course/per semester	\$924

Students are eligible to take one or more classes or the intensive program. Students may reside in campus housing (based on availability) and purchase campus meal plans.
