In 2016 there were over 100 Federal Register Notices; 7 New Laws/Executive Orders; 19 OFAC General Licenses; 16 Country Policy Changes; 50+ Web Notices and Agency Guidance; Numerous Agency IT System Changes; Penalty Inflation Increases and Significant changes in Agency Key Positions. In March 2017, the U.S. Government announced record-setting \$1.19 billion penalty for violations of export controls and economic sanctions. ***Could your company be next?***
