**What export opportunities will this create?**

The United States exported nearly 50 percent of the \$ 2.9 billion in medical devices Canada imported in 2015. This sector is expecting a 4% growth rate through 2019. With a large, stable construction market and a robust green building segment driven by market forces and government policies, Canada is a large potential market for U.S. exporters. Infrastructure projects will include repair of traffic arteries, local roads, street lighting, bike paths, renovation work, investments in water infrastructures, and smart city technology investments.

Eleven major minerals and metals make Canada one of the top five mining countries in the world. Mining includes mineral extraction, smelting, fabrication, and manufacturing. The 2016 budget proposes to provide over \$ 1 billion over four years starting in 2017-18 to support clean technology including forestry, fisheries, mining, energy, and agriculture sectors.
