Refund of Tuition

- 100% refund prior to the course start date
- 95% refund within the first 15 calendar days of course start date
- 40% refund between 16-30 calendar days of the course start date
- No refund after the 31st calendar day of the course start date

Financial Aid

A 15 % tuition discount is given to Saint Vincent College alumni who enroll in graduate courses. A 15% tuition discount is also applied to Excelsa employees who enter the graduate program in Management: Operational Excellence. Students living or working in Westmoreland County, PA are eligible for a 10% tuition discount.

Application for Financial Aid

To be eligible for Federal aid a student enrolled in a master's program at Saint Vincent College or Seminary must be registered **part-time**, a minimum of five (5) credits, one (1) course at the graduate level per semester, or be registered **full-time**, a minimum of nine (9) credits, one (1) course at the graduate level per semester.

To apply for financial aid you must file the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at www.fafsa.gov. Saint Vincent College must be a designated recipient of this information. Our Federal School Code is 003368. All FAFSA applications should be filed after January 1 of each year. A student who does not file the FAFSA will not be eligible to receive federal aid.

Federal Direct Student Loan

Federal Direct Loans are low-interest loans to pay for the cost of a student's education. The lender is the U.S. Department of Education. You borrow directly from the federal government and have a single contact – your loan servicer- for everything related to repayment, even if you receive Direct Loans at different schools. The maximum amount a student may borrow is \$20,500 per academic year. The aggregate amount a student may borrow is \$138,500. Please go to www.studentloans.gov to learn more about the Federal Direct Loan Program. First-time borrowers are required to complete the Federal Direct Master Promissory Note and Federal Direct Entrance Counseling.

Federal Direct Graduate PLUS Loan

Federal Direct Graduate PLUS Loans are to pay for the cost of a student's education. The lender is the U.S. Department of Education. You borrow directly from the federal government and have a single contact – your loan servicer- for everything related to repayment, even if you receive Direct Loans at different schools.
